<b>Title</b>	Free movement of capital and payments between EU and SEE countries

<b>Description</b>	<p>The lecture will combine classical teaching with an interactive discussion of real-life cases and/or hypothetical cases. Students will be required to read designated materials prior to the lecture, in order to be able to take part in discussions.
